TERMS OF SETTLEMENT BETWEEN THE PETITIONER AND THE RESPONDENT

1. That a decree of dissolution of the Marriage between the Petitioner and the Respondent conducted at the Ikoyi Marriage Registry, Lagos on the 24th December, 2020, in accordance with the Provisions of the Marriage Act be entered;
2. That both parties cannot reasonably be expected to live with each other again having stayed apart for over three years from the date of the marriage mentioned above in paragraph 1;
3. That there are no children in the Marriage between the Petitioner and the Respondent;
4. That both parties have no claim(s) whatsoever against each other that the dissolution of the marriage between them;
5. That both parties have agreed mutually to go their separate ways as their differences are irreconcilable;
6. That both parties to bear their cost of litigation
7. That both parties shall not make any further claims against each other in connection with this suit, save for the enforcement of the terms herein agreed by both parties.
