Claimant counsel: at the last adjourned date we adjourned for the purpose of bringing a term of settlement before the court.and the counsel to the EFCC promised to by today and he is in court.

Counsel to the EFCC it is true that on the last adjourned date that this case was adjourned to file terms of settlement.

On the 2nd thought we thought this matter is for enforcement of fundamental right and that if parties have an understanding the matter can be withdrawn by the applicant.
