The charge was read to defendant in English Language, he understood same and pleads:

1st Count - Guilty
2nd Count - Guilty
3rd Count - Guilty

PROSECUTION FACTS: Sometime in March, 2024 within the Kubwa axis the said defendant was apprehended upon intelligence report which led to the apprehension of defendant. He was arrested by the EFCC officials and taken to their office. His statement was taken under words of caution and he was also granted bail upon provision of reliable sureties. Upon arrest of defendant, he was caught with a mobile phone being his instrument of criminality which is an iPhone 14 Promax. Defendant benefited the sum of £1,000 in total of which he has restituted the same sum

JUDGMENT

"You are hereby found guilty as charged

ALLOCUTUS

DEFENDANT: I'm truly sorry. I'm an agent for a car dealership, I promise not to engage in crime again.

SENTENCING

Having considered the allocutus of the defendant and his counsel, I will proceed to sentence defendant accordingly.

COUNT 1: On the 1st count, defendant is hereby sentenced to 6 months imprisonment or an option of N500, 000.00

COUNT: On the 2nd count defendant is hereby sentenced 6 months imprisonment or an option of N500, 000.00

COUNT 3: On the 3rd count, defendant is hereby sentenced to 6 months imprisonment or an option to pay N500, 000.00.

All sentencing and options are to run consecutively. Defendant to be remanded in prison custody pending when fine is paid.
