Considering the length of time this matter has taken since the filing of this suit on the 6/6/2022 parties have exchanged pleadings as the record of this court speaks for itself, hence I shall award the sum of N100, 000.00costsin favour of the defendant.

This matter is hereby struck out from the cause list based on the letter of discontinuance.
