## **JUDGMENT**

**OBILA:-** We had earlier filed plea bargain agreement with the Court. This was borne out of the fact that the Defendant had admitted his guilt. We therefore urge the Court to convict him as per the plea bargain agreement and sentence him accordingly.

**BOBBY:-** We agree.

### **COURT:-**

It is procedural that upon conviction of an Accused person, sentencing proceedings shall be conducted wherein the Court shall hear Allocutus of the Convict whereof necessary mitigating factors shall be taken into account in sentencing such a Convict.

However, in this case, there is a Plea Bargain Agreement duly filed, that clearly would have taken care of the procedure.

Accordingly, pursuant to the Plea Bargain Agreement between the Prosecution and the Defendant, Defendant is hereby convicted as charged.

## **SENTENCING**

Pursuant to the Plea Bargain Agreement, Convict is hereby sentenced to one (1) year in prison with option of fine of ₦300,000.00 (Three Hundred Thousand Naira).

Convict shall also forfeit his iphone 14 pro max, iphone 7 plus, Samsung Galaxy AS, HP Laptop, A Toyota Corrola Model 2014 Car and 1,002,547,631 (\$1,002.22) to the Federal Government of Nigeria.

Convict shall similarly depose to affidavit of good character before this Court.
