**JUDGEMENT**

The Petitioner via his petition for a decree of dissolution of marriage dated 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2023 and filed same day is claiming for the following reliefs:

- a) A decree of judicial separation.
- b) A decree of dissolution of marriage on the ground that since the marriage, the respondent has behaved in such a way that the petitioner cannot reasonably be expected to live with the respondent, conducts which the petitioner considers intolerable which has made the marriage to breakdown irretrievably.

The parties with their respective Counsel after series of meetings have agreed to settle their differences amicably out of Court by way of memorandum of settlement on the following terms:

1. The parties hereby agree that the marriage has broken down irretrievably and that there is the urgent need for the parties to honourably go their separate ways so as to avoid harming each other.
2. That there was no co-habitation immediately after the marriage and there is no fruit of the womb as a result of non-cohabitation.
3. That there is equally no property be it mobile or landed between the parties that requires to be shared.
4. That the parties are desirous of an urgent need for a decree of judicial separation and a decree of dissolution of marriage on the ground that the marriage between the parties have broken down irretrievably.
5. That the parties have agreed that the terms of settlement herein be adopted and entered as a consent judgement in this petition.
6. That no cost shall be awarded against any of the parties.

Terms of settlement dated 19/4/2024 and filed on 9/10/24 by the parties to the petition is hereby adopted as consent judgement in the terms filed by the parties.
