CONSENT JUDGEMENT

WHEREAS the parties have agreed to settle the dispute amicably and urged the Court to enter the following as judgement in this suit:

1. That, the parties (Claimant and Defendants) have agreed that the plaintiff shall pay the purchase price of the two (2) shops at the going rate in 2010 when the shops were sold to tenants by the Defendant. The price being N4,000,000 (Four Million Naira) only per shop. The Claimant shall pay N8,000,000 (Eight Million Naira) only for Shops 19A and 19B, Block B17, Garki Model Market, Abuja.
2. That, the sum of N2,000,000 (Two Million Naira) only shall be deducted from the initial sales of shops within Block B17, Garki Model Market being the Claimant's share of agency fee between her and Nelson Emmenuel on the sum of N48,000,000 (Forty Eight Million Naira) only being the purchase price and share of N200,000 (Two Hundred Thousand Naira) only which the Claimant included to the sales price of Eight (8) shops within Block 17, Garki Model Market, Abuja.
3. That the Claimant shall be entitled to the sum of N1,200,000 (One Million Two Hundred Thousand Naira) only from Agency fees as in Clause 2 above

and N800,000 (Eight Hundred Thousand Naira) only from the sale of Eight (8) shops between the Claimant and Nelson Emmanuel.

4. That
5. Petitioner and the 1st Respondent lived together in cohabitation until the separation as of 12th October, 2020 till date due to irreconcilable differences.
6. Parties have lived apart from and independent of each other for 8 months and are desirous of dissolving the marriage.
7. The marriage produced no child.
8. **Juliana Modupe Adeyemi**, the Petitioner filed a petition for divorce against **Ademola Abraham Bamigboye** dated 9th November, 2020 and filed on the 10th November, 2020 seeking the following reliefs:
 - a. A decree of dissolution of marriage.
 - b. ~~N1,000,000.00~~ **(One Million Naira)** being the cost of the said suit.

NOW the parties HEREBY AGREE as follows:

- i. That the marriage be dissolved by the Honorable Court.
- ii. Parties agree to live separately and apart from each other, as if not married and each party shall be free from any interference, harassment, authority or control whatsoever of the other party.
- iii. Parties hereby agree that the forgoing terms of settlement shall be filed in court and that same be entered and made the consent judgement of this honorable Court in respect of this suit.
- iv. Parties shall bear their respective cost.

THE PARTIES HEREBY CONFIRM that the above Terms represent the Agreement between them and hereby agree that they be adopted by this Honorable court and entered as Consent Judgement between the Petitioner and the 1st Respondent.
