JUDGEMENT

The Petitioner , vide a petition filed in the registry of this Honourable Court on the 11th May 2023, sought the following reliefs:

- a) A Decree of dissolution of the marriage between the Petitioner and the Respondent on the ground that the marriage has broken down irretrievably, the parties having lived apart for a period exceeding three (3) years immediately preceding the presentation of this petition.

And whereas:

The Respondent through his Counsel on the 11th day of March 2023 vide an oral application sought the indulgence of this Court to file a Terms of

Settlement on the foundation that the Respondent also seeks the dissolution of the marriage with the Petitioner.

Pursuant to the said application by the Respondent, parties have had several meetings with their respective Counsel in attendance whereof the parties, after exhaustive discussions, mutually agreed that:

- a. The marriage between the Petitioner and the Respondent be dissolved on the ground that the marriage has broken down irretrievably.
- b. And the parties hereby agreed that these terms be adopted as consent judgement of this Honourable Court.

The Court have taken cognizance of the terms of settlement dated 24/4/2024 and filed on 14/5/2024 entered into by the parties and endorsed by their respective Counsel. Sequel to paragraph 3(a) thereof the marriage between the Petitioner and the Respondent is hereby dissolved on the ground that the marriage have broken down irretrievably.
